
### **BSV** – Phase II



- Largest public infrastructure program ever constructed in Santa Clara
- Includes the recently completed 10-mile, twostation Berryessa Extension Project (SVBX) and the Phase II Extension Project (BSVII Program)

#### **DBE/SBE Participation**

- DBE: 15%
   Only DBE firms certified by CUCP will count toward DBE participation.
- SBE: 20%
   Only SBE firms certified by VTA or California
   DGS will be counted for SBE participation.
- The 20% SBE goal is inclusive of the DBE goal, for this contract.

- 2. Any other certifying agency, as part of the California Unified Certification Program (CUCP)

# State/Locally Funded Contracts

Small Business Enterprise (SBE)

Certification

#### Certification by

- 1. VTA
- 2. Department of General Services (DGS) SB micro only
- 3. DBE Certification may be accepted



## The "Why" to Certify!

## Why get certified?

- 1. VTA has goals to meet
  - a) BART Silicon Valley Phase II (BSVII)
    - i. Owner Controlled Insurance Program (OCIP)
- 2. Net 15 Policy
- Set-aside program for small businesses on \$150k or smaller purchases



### **Small Business Certifications**

#### What Certification(s) should I pursue?

#### **SBE Certification**

- US Citizen (or lawfully admitted permanent residents)
- Must meet Small Business size standard prescribed by 13 CFR 121, cap of \$30.4M
- Real and Independent
- Any race, ethnicity, or gender

#### **DBE** Certification

- US Citizen (or lawfully admitted permanent residents)
- Small Business size standard prescribed by 121 CFR 13, \$30.4M cap
- PNW below Adjusted \$1.32M
- Ownership/Control
- Member of minority groups: who are Black Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian-Pacific Americans, Subcontinent Asian Americans, women, or other minorities found to be disadvantaged by the SBA
- Independent
